SPEAK OUT FOR YOUR PENSION!

Speak out against paying more:

- the government wants you to pay 50% more in contributions – a rise from 6.4% to 9.8% by 2014
- teachers will pay on average £1,145 more a year; headteachers will pay £1,965

Speak out against working longer:

- you may be forced to work until you're 66 then 68

Speak out against getting less:

- changes in the way pension increases are calculated mean a £10,000 a year pension has already lost £150 this year
- under a career average scheme, rather than final salary, pension benefits will drop at least a further 15%
- independent school staff may not be allowed in the Teachers' Pension Scheme in the future

Speak out for your pension:

- come to an ATL roadshow
- download or order materials to share with colleagues
- write to your local MP demanding a halt to changes
- support ATL in all its efforts to secure the best pension for you
